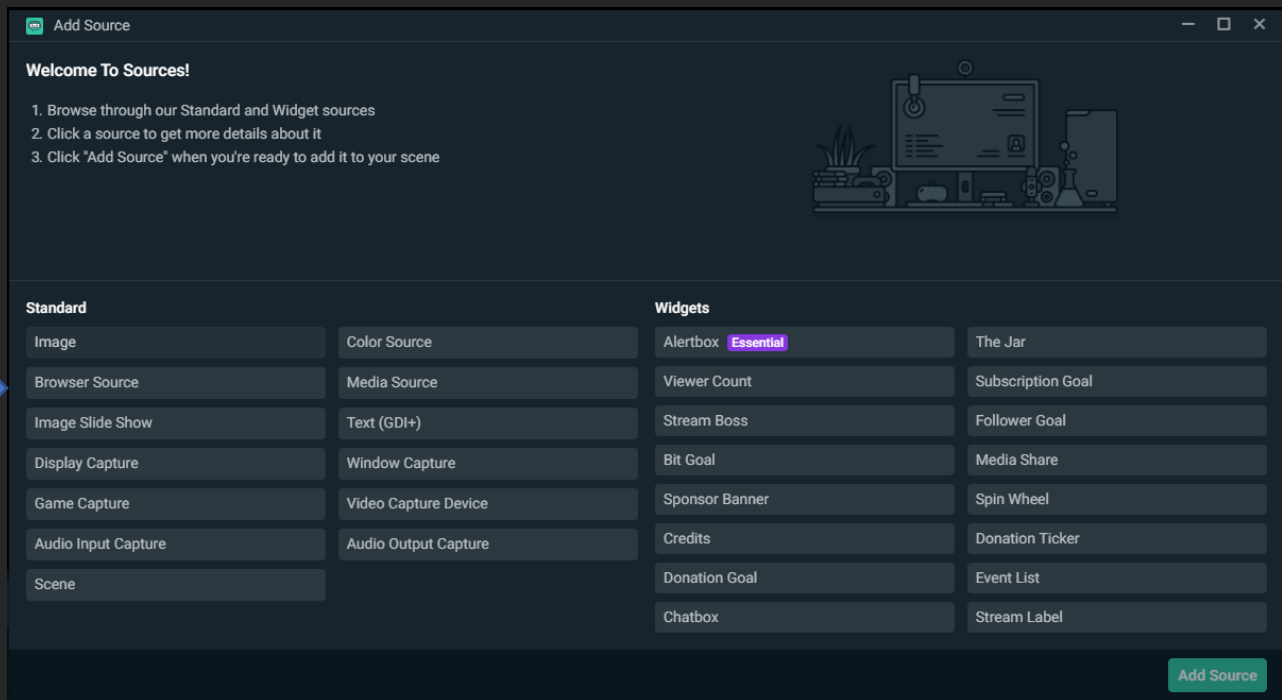




In OBS click on the plus “+” icon to add a new source.
